To be eligible for a job-embedded license as a school counselor, you must meet the criteria below.

1. Complete ALL of the following courses in the MTSU Professional Counseling Program with a grade of B or better.

- COUN 6120 Counseling Exceptional Children
- COUN 6160 Foundations of School Counseling
- COUN 6165 Advanced School Counseling
- 2. Pass the Praxis II #5422.
- 3. Have completed or are currently enrolled in COUN 6270 Practicum in Counseling.
- 3. Have been previously or currently employed in a formal capacity in a PreK–12 setting (e,g., teacher, graduation coach, school services personnel, etc.). Determining whether this criterion is met is at the discretion of the program faculty.
- 4. Must maintain student status in our program by being currently enrolled in classes.
- 5. Must have met and continue to meet all program requirements and dispositions throughout their enrollment in the Professional Counseling Program.
