



# MTSU PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING PROGRAM CACREP ANNUAL REPORT

## REPORTING YEAR: 2024-2025

In accordance with CACREP Section 4: Evaluation in the Program, the following data summarize key program outcomes for the most recent academic year. These data are reviewed annually by program faculty and shared with students, alumni, and stakeholders to ensure transparency and continuous improvement.



### Number of Graduates

During the past academic year, the MTSU Professional Counseling Program graduated a total of 20 students across both concentrations:

- Clinical Mental Health Counseling: 11
- School Counseling: 9



### Degree Completion Rate

Represents the percentage of students completing the program within the expected time frame (typically 3 years for full-time students, 4–5 years for part-time students).

- Overall Program Completion Rate: 100%



### Licensure or Certification Examination Pass Rate

Reflects the percentage of graduates who successfully passed a required licensure or certification examination (e.g., NCE, Praxis #5422).

- Licensure/Certification Examination Pass Rate: 100%



### Combined Employment and Doctoral Admissions Rate

Represents graduates who were employed in the counseling field or accepted into a doctoral program within six months of graduation.

- Employment and Doctoral Admissions Rate: 95%
